<u>Eco-Schools Topic</u> Waste	<u>Action</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Write letters to Biffa to request new recycling bins (Paper and food waste). 2) Food waste to be recycled and placed into the compost bin in the garden area. 3) Eco councillors to develop a recycling award to be given to the best recycling class. 4) To raise awareness of the important of recycling through an assembly and making posters to be put up around the school. 5) To sign the school up to take part in the big battery hunt and work alongside Mrs. Winstone to organise a uniform swap. 	<u>Duration</u> To begin in the spring term and continue throughout the year.	<u>Monitoring Method</u> Eco councillors to monitor amount of recycling being taken place in each class fortnightly.
