PSHE

Explore similarities and differences between themselves and others
Explain the difference between unkindness, teasing and bullying
Explain the school rules and how these rules help to keep everybody safe.
Recognise and explain what is fair/unfair and kind/unkind;
Identify some of the people who are special to them.
Recognise and name some of the qualities that make a person special to them.
Recognise that they belong to various groups and communities such as their family; Explain how these people help us and we can also help them to help us.

Geography

Understand that a world map shows every country, continent, sea and ocean.
Identify and name the 7 continents of the year and identify these on a world map. Identify familiar countries, landmarks and animals native to these continents.
Identify and name the 5 oceans. Label these on a world map.

Use tools to edit photographs

Talk about preparing for a new baby.
Look at a picture of baby Jesus from Christian tradition. What can pupils tell about him from the picture?
