

This term:

In Maths, we will be working on our 3, 4 and 8 times tables. This will involve multiplication and division facts. We will also work on addition and subtraction skills.

In English, we will be studying the book 'Tom's Sausage Lion' by Michael Murpurgo. The children will be developing skills to write a diary entry and a newspaper report.

In Geography, we will be looking at how the Earth is constructed and how mountains are formed. Then we will research how Volcanoes and Earthquakes occur. We will also look at their effects on Earth.

In Art, we will be focusing on drawing and observation skills. We will be developing the skills of creating tone, texture and detail.

In Music, we will be focusing on the question 'What stories does music tell us about the past?' We will be listening and responding to music.

In RE, we will be studying the story of Noah and relating it to our own experiences. The children will make simple links between the story of Noah and promises that Christians make at a wedding ceremony.
