English

During term 1, we will be using 'Varjak Paw' as our class text. A challenging, imaginative text that will engage us right from the start. We will be working on our spellings, punctuation and grammar to produce a range of pieces of writing:

- Writing the story from another character's point of view
- Writing a newspaper report

Mathematics

During term 1, we will be starting our journey in Maths by focussing on two main areas of the Maths curriculum

- Place Value
- Geometry (properties of shapes) We will also hold daily M.O.T (Maths on Track) sessions to support our learning in Mathematics.

Science

In Science this term, we will be learning about sound.

History

Religious Education

French

Music

Design Technology
