## English

During term 2, we will be using 'The Tin Forest' as our class text. A picture book full of imagination and ideas that will engage us right from the start. We will be working on our spellings, punctuation and grammar to produce a range of writing:

- Ending to a story
- Non Chronological reports

## Mathematics

During term 2, we will be continue our journey in Maths by focussing on two main areas of the Maths curriculum

- Multiplication and Division
- Addition and Subtraction

We will also hold daily M.O.T (Maths on Track) sessions to support our learning in Mathematics.

## Science

In Science this term, we will be learning about electricity.

We will complete some investigations and work practically a lot of the time.

## Geography

In Geography this term, we will be learning about the rainforests.

## Religious Education
