English

During term 3, we will be using 'The Firework-Maker's Daughter' as our class text. We will be working on our spellings, punctuation and grammar to produce a range of writing:

- **Writing our own similar story**
- **Writing a recount of the story from another character**
- **Instruction writing**

Mathematics

During term 3, we will be continue our journey in Maths by focussing on two main areas of the Maths curriculum

- **Multiplication and Division**
- **Addition and Subtraction**

We will also hold daily M.O.T (Maths on Track) sessions to support our learning in Mathematics.

Science

In Science this term, we will be learning about **Animals Including Humans**. We will complete some investigations and work practically a lot of the time. We will finish our unit by writing a report on the human body.

History

In History this term, we will be learning about the **Vikings**. Our question for this unit will be:

Do the Vikings deserve their reputation and were they more successful than the Anglo-Saxons?

Religious Education

During term 3, we will learn about **Christianity**. We will study many parts of the religion and by the end of the term, will be able to share our knowledge!

French

In French this term, we will learning about our **families**.

We will learn how to read, write, listen and talk with our new knowledge and will be able to complete a conversation at the end of the term.

Music

In Music this term, Year 4 will be having external **ukulele** lessons from Mr Davies. These will take place on Wednesday afternoons. At the end of the unit, we will be inviting parents in to see a performance.

Physical Education

PE lessons take place on Tuesday afternoons. These lessons will be led by Mr English. For this term, the focus will be on **dance**.
